The Leadership Council met by teleconference to consider the 2020-21 Audit Report and Audited Financial Statements presented by the Office of the Auditor General of Canada.

1.0 Call to Order

The Chairperson called the meeting to order at 1:32 PM, and welcomed everyone attending the teleconference.





2.0 Reflection/Prayer

Mr. Antoine led the Leadership Council in an opening prayer.

3.0 Attendance

The Chairperson asked everyone on the teleconference to introduce themselves. The Senior Advisor, Governance recorded the attendance as above.

4.0 Declarations of Conflict of Interest

There were no conflict of interest declarations for this meeting.

5.0 Agenda

The Chairperson of the Leadership Council reviewed the agenda for the meeting.

6.0 2020/21 Audit Report

The OAG team reviewed their Audit Report, which included their Audit Opinion and status, and risk-based audit, accounting and financial reporting results and findings, and recommendations to resolve concerns.

Following on concerns raised in the prior year, the OAG identified significant risks in the areas of Audit readiness, compliance with the *Financial Administration Act*, billings, inventory, critical accounting estimates, and the growing accumulated deficit. The audit identified no issues in the areas of payroll and management control of overrides.

The Audit resulted in an unmodified opinion with other relevant matters noted in paragraphs on the Audited Financial Statements to assist understanding of the Audit. Following adjustments the Audited Financial Statements were deemed to be free of material misstatement.

7.0 Approval of the 2020/21 Audited Financial Statements

After the OAG team left the call, the A/CFO and CEO reviewed the 2020/21 Audited Financial Statements with the Council.

Council thanked Ms. Johnson for her hard work to complete the Audit, and looked forward to the signed auditors report being included in the Annual Report to be submitted to the Minister. Members noted the increase in debt for the fiscal year, and the process to confirm variances from Budget in quarterly variance reports. Council also confirmed that pandemic-related costs and off-sets were included in the results.



On a motion duly moved and seconded, the Leadership Council of the Northwest Territories Health and Social Services Authority approved the 2020/21 Audited Financial Statements, as presented on November 18, 2021.
