


RE-ENTRY PLANNING



1 EARLY RE-ENTRY *before evacuation order ends*

Limited NTHSSA staff will be contacted and asked to return to the community before the evacuation order ends. They will work to prepare a ramp-up of essential health and social services.



2 BASIC SERVICES

When the evacuation order ends, basic life sustaining services will be available to residents. **Many services will not be available including:**

- Regular obstetrics / birthing
- Dialysis
- IV Therapy
- Chemotherapy

Individuals being advised not to return (dialysis, chemotherapy, IV therapy, individuals with advanced or high-risk pregnancies) will be transitioned to Medical Travel if supports to evacuees end.

3 SERVICE RAMP UP

As community members, including staff, return back to their community NTHSSA will begin increasing services and making regular announcements about progress. A service level dashboard will be provided and updated daily, or as often as required to update on service levels.

4 FULL RESUMPTION

It is estimated that full resumption of programs and services may take up to one month after the evacuation order has ended. As staff return this process may be quicker than anticipated. Regular progress updates will be provided

At this stage or just before we will repatriate patients and residents who had been evacuated to other provinces during the in-patient and Long Term Care evacuations. This will only apply to those whose home community is not under evacuation order.
